The primary goal of the BSA is to provide the School Board with a clear understanding of their unique strengths and challenges from an objective, supportive viewpoint. Annual use helps board leadership monitor progress toward consistent improvement and growth. This is often done in tandem with an HOS 360 or our TrustED® School Leader (TSL) Assessment, showing the full commitment of the school board to professionally review the leadership acumen of the school.

This valuable tool is best used as an annual summative assessment. **NOTE:** *Although the tool is highly related to the Policy Governance model, it performs very well with any style of board structure.*

## QUESTIONS, TYPES & DATA ANALYSIS

A majority of the questions use a 5-point Likert Scale (1 being low, 5 being high). Once the assessment is closed, we will process and analyze the data in order to provide you with an understandable and useable report. There are open-ended questions on this survey.

## THE LOOK AND FEEL OF THE ASSESSMENT

The school colors and logo will be incorporated into the self-assessment. Once distributed, this can be completed online via computer, tablet, or another mobile device.

## FOLLOW-UP REPORT

The report contains three basic elements. Results are:

1. **Displayed** in easily-understood tables and narrative.
2. **Summarized** with aggregated scores for **key categories**, as well as the top **strengths** and the lowest-rated areas.
3. **Reviewed** in a **one-hour consult** with the Board Chairman, and/or the entire board.
